Harnessing the power of culture and cultural diversity for social cohesion and well-being by promoting cultural participation, the mobility of artists and the protection of heritage; a tool achieve fair EU

Inclusiveness fundamental value and asset for Europe's Culture, Society and Economy.

Inclusion + Diversity EU

- EU Commission's New Action plan on Integration and Inclusion 2021-2027.
- EU Anti-Racism Action Plan, the Gender Equality Strategy 2020-2025, the LGBTIQ Strategy 2020-2025 and the EU Roma Strategic Framework for Equality, Inclusion and Participation,
- CE Programme integrates Gender Equality Strategy + Action Plan on Diversity and boosting equality and fairness. – *Priority Social Inclusion to promote societal resilience and enhance social inclusion of all those disadvantaged as well as intercultural dialogue.*



International to National Policy

- The Arts Council National Agency for the Arts -Arts Policy –EHRD 2019
- Recognises inequalities exist, people experience barriers to engaging with, making and participating in the arts. Ethnicity or Religion, Gender ID or sexual orientation, socio-economic background, age, member of minority group or a lack of accommodation for persons with disability.



Equality Human Rights & Diversity (EHRD) Policy

- Arts Council of Ireland has embedded EHRD into all its awards and funding schemes and is actively seeking to support work that delivers equitable opportunities or outcomes for those involved
- Also putting in place a number of new measures around accessibility including a clear framework around **access supports** at all stages of the application process



EHRD + Arts Participation

Arts Council of Ireland

- ‘... every person living in Ireland has the right to create, engage with, enjoy and participate in the arts.’ [Arts Council Ireland EHRD Policy \(2019\)](#)
- Builds on previous policies [Arts & Health \(2010\)](#), [Cultural Diversity and the Arts \(2010\)](#), [Arts & Disability \(2012\)](#), & initiatives e.g. [Shift in Perspective \(2012\)](#), [Ignite \(2014-15\)](#)
- New overarching policy being developed in the area of Arts Participation in 2021

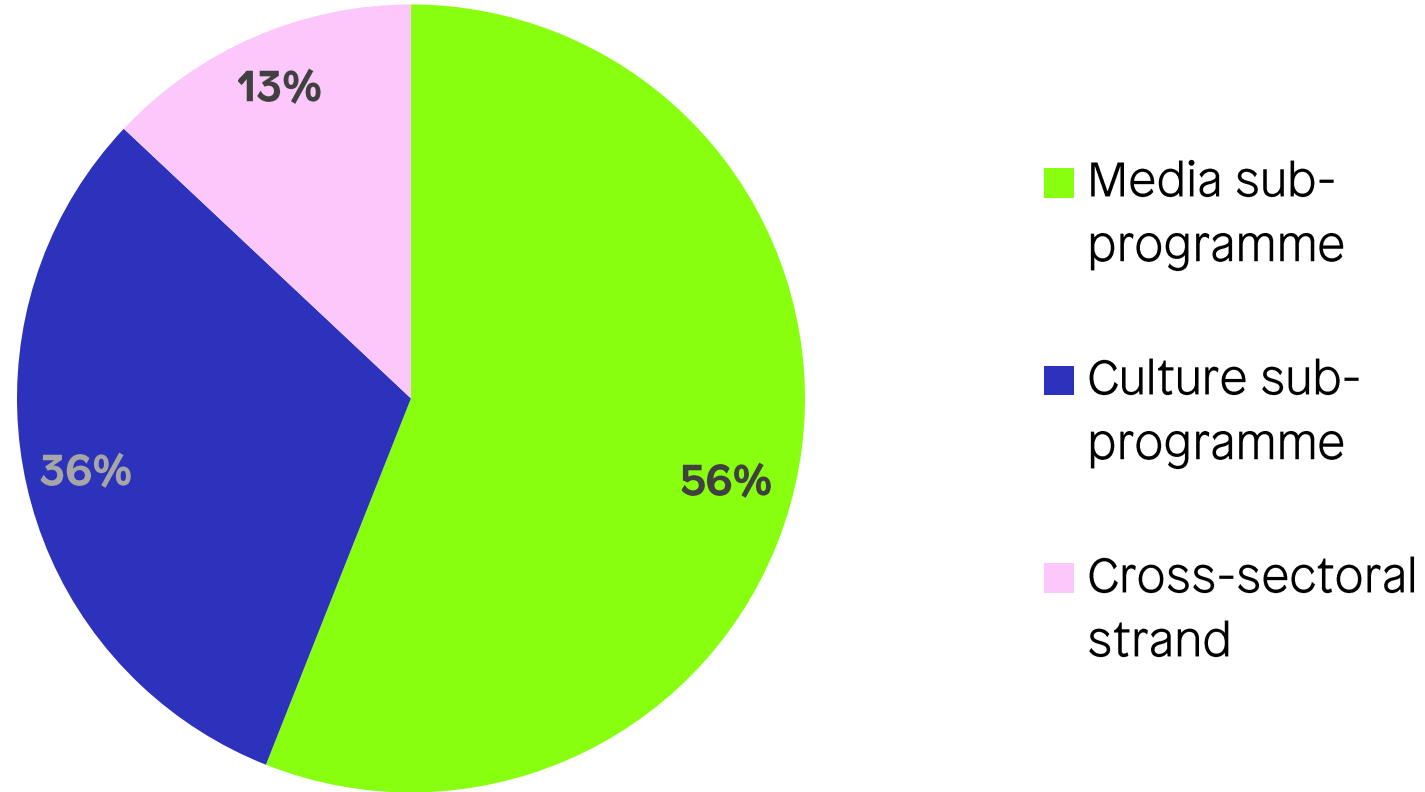

- **Environment** Green Deal for Europe- CCP adopt more environmentally friendly practices
- **Audience** – access to art and culture and audience development
- **Annual sector-specific calls** – Architecture, Music, Book Sector & Cultural Heritage

- Become member of European Network
- Artist –CE Projects mini funding hubs- Open Calls/ Mobility Awards
- Research and develop your project and what Creative Europe priorities interests you
- Assess Long term plans-Project that builds on organisation or your own personal strengths
- Partner Search – deepen existing national/International relationships + search out new ones
- Extent project complementary to cultural actions implemented at national, regional or local level?
- Realistic budget/ size of project for your capacity
- Attend application workshops and events about other Creative Europe Projects
